



## Excursion during the 11<sup>th</sup> Assembly of the World Council of Churches to Gutach und Hausach - September, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>

### Saturday at Gutach

- 10.20 Guests arrive at the railway station Hausach.  
Transfer by coach to the Black Forest Open Air Museum "Vogtsbauernhof".
- 10.40 Guided tour by the ministers Hans-Michael Uhl and Herbert Kumpf: "How Christianity and Christian traditions have changed throughout the ages",  
and: Information on ecclesiastical commitment in today's tourism.



transfer by cars to the lunch place

- 12.45 Lunch at Rommele Farmhouse
- 14.00 short walk (one kilometre) to the village centre of Gutach
- 14.30 village square Gutach:  
Address of welcome by the mayor of Gutach Siegfried Eckert.  
Guided tours in smaller groups to the war memorial, to the village church, and to the Protestant parish hall where we can talk about ecumenical cooperation.

16.00 Coffee break at the Protestant parish hall with "Black Forest Cherry Gateau"

16.45 Staying together a bit longer, going for a walk, perhaps visiting the "Hasemann Museum".

18.30 Evening meal in the Protestant parish hall Gutach

19.30 Evening meeting in the parish hall:  
Singing along, maybe introducing each other.

21.30 Guests are picked up by their hosts.

- 13.15 Transfer to the inn/restaurant "Landhaus Hechtsberg".
- 13.45 Lunch there.
